Board of Education Report – Suzie Stevinson (reported by: Danielle Fredella)

- People may have read in the Bernardsville news that the "debt" of approximately \$250,000 that the Somerset Hills
 School District has been alleging Bedminster owes for the past several years was in fact, as Bedminster indicated,
 not a debt at all. At this time, Somerset Hills is actually the debtor owing Bedminster approximately \$87,000. This
 was a result of a private audit that the school districts agreed to assess the situation. The audit also resulted in a
 reduction in HS tuition. For those that don't know, Bedminster is a sending district and we pay a 'per student' rate to
 send our HS students to Bernardsville.
