Elementary Principal's Report: Corby Swan

We are one solid month into school. Our teachers have set their expectations and are building their classroom communities.

Teachers are in the midst of making pacing adjustments to our math program as we enter year #3 so that more content can be covered.

We have implemented a Student Attendance Review Team for elementary school. Our plan is to reach out to families and engage them in understanding the importance of their child being in school. We meet twice per month and address trends while communicating with families of students who are chronically absent. The goal here is not just to contact them but to find out why they have been chronically absent and to offer resources and assistance from the school. The team consists of Mr. Swan, our elementary school counselor, our Thrive school social worker, and our attendance coordinator.
